Workshop Description:

Sexuality is a topic that is difficult, or at least uncomfortable, for many parents and professionals to discuss, however it is a topic that will ultimately be an issue with the majority individuals on the autism spectrum. This workshop will begin with an overview of general issues regarding sexuality in ASD. Topics to be reviewed include: sexual development, sexuality knowledge, sexual behaviors (both appropriate and inappropriate), issues regarding consent, and common parent concerns. Issues related to sexuality curricula and teaching methods will also be discussed. Although sexuality is an issue that often comes to the forefront in adolescence, information on sexuality is important for individuals of all ages. Audience questions and discussion will be welcomed.
