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## LITTLE MIRACLES PRESCHOOL

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Little Miracles Preschool program offers a center-based full day program to 3-5 year-old children with Autism Spectrum Disorders (ASD) or Pervasive Developmental Disorder (PDD).

The goal of this program is to provide children with autism a highly structured, intensive learning environment which includes individualized programming using an approach based on the principle of applied behavior analysis.

Programming focuses on learning readiness skills, academics, social skills, play skills and self-help skills.

Parents receive training individually, twice a month. Teachers make home visits to ensure generalization of skills and appropriate behaviors across environments.

The Preschool is certified by the NYS Education Department and is funded through a contract with the NYC Board of Education.

## SPECIAL EDUCATION ITINERANT TEACHER (SEIT) PROGRAM

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SEIT services are for children 3-5 year of age who are classified by their school district's Committee on Preschool Education (CPSE) as a preschooler with a disability. SEIT services are provided by a certified special education teacher. SEIT services are individualized to the needs of the child, and may include:

- Implementation of the child's Individualized Education Program (IEP);
- Implementation, coordination, and monitoring of the child's behavior management program;
- Collaboration with preschool directors and teachers;
- Coordination of the child's educational programs with teachers, therapists and parents;
- Parent trainings, observations and home visits.

## SPECIAL EDUCATION TEACHER SUPPORT SERVICES (SETSS) PROGRAM

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Eden II's SETSS model is similar to that of SEIT. Services can be provided in a variety of settings and goals are individualized to the student. Students who receive SETSS services are school-aged children, 5 years old and up.



## EDEN II'S SCHOOL PROGRAM

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The school program offers a center-based full day program to 5-21-year old people with autism/PDD. The goal of the program is to help the person with autism achieve his or her full potential.

Programming includes goals in communication, academics, social skills, self-help skills, and the promotion of adaptive behavior.

The vocational and secondary school programs for adolescents and young adults focus upon development of vocational skills, independent work habits as well as community integration.

Community outings and experiences are an integral component of the program.

Students are provided with specific instruction to promote development of employable skills including domestics, crafts, gardening, assembly and office-related activities

Students receive intensive speech and language services throughout their school day.

Psychological services are provided as an integral part of the student's reinforcement and, where needed, a behavior management plan can be implemented.

The Eden II School is a non-public New York State approved day school.

**Eden II recognizes and is committed to the needs of the family as well as the child with autism. Parental involvement is an integral component of a successful educational program and parents are encouraged to participate actively in the child's education.**
